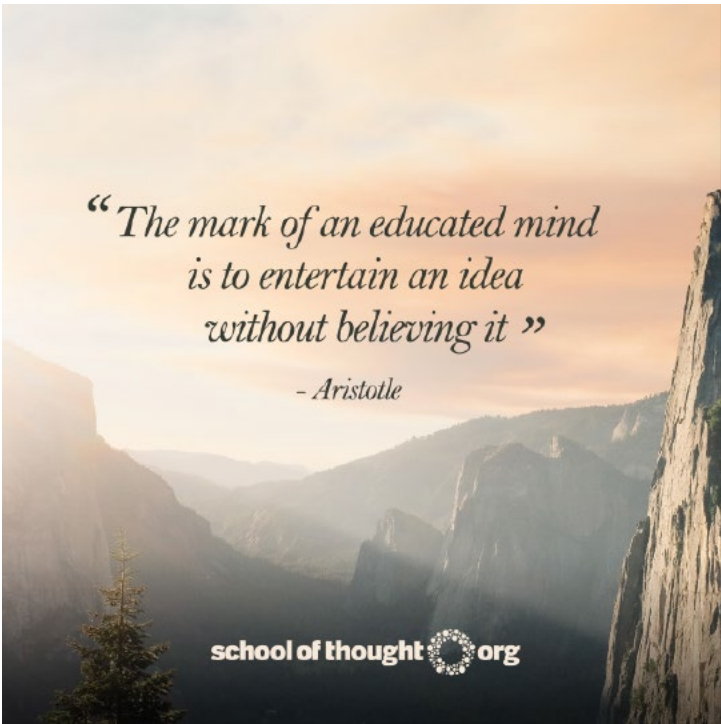
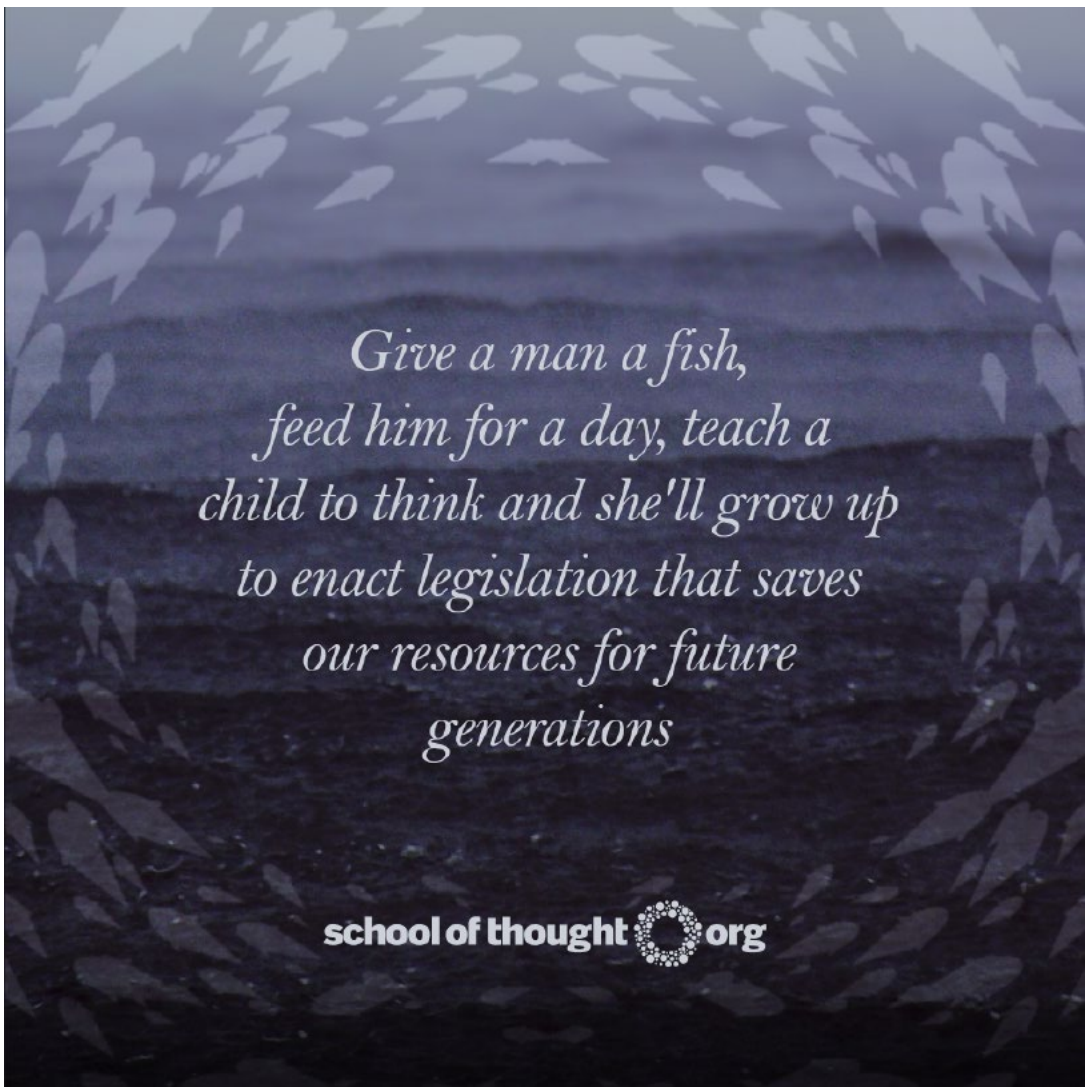
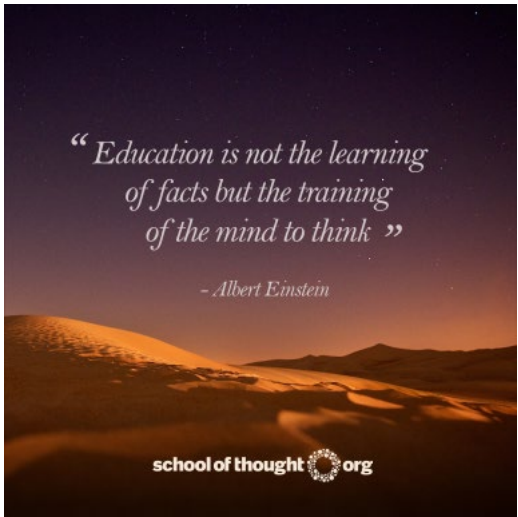
Would you mind sharing something to help promote rationality and reason?

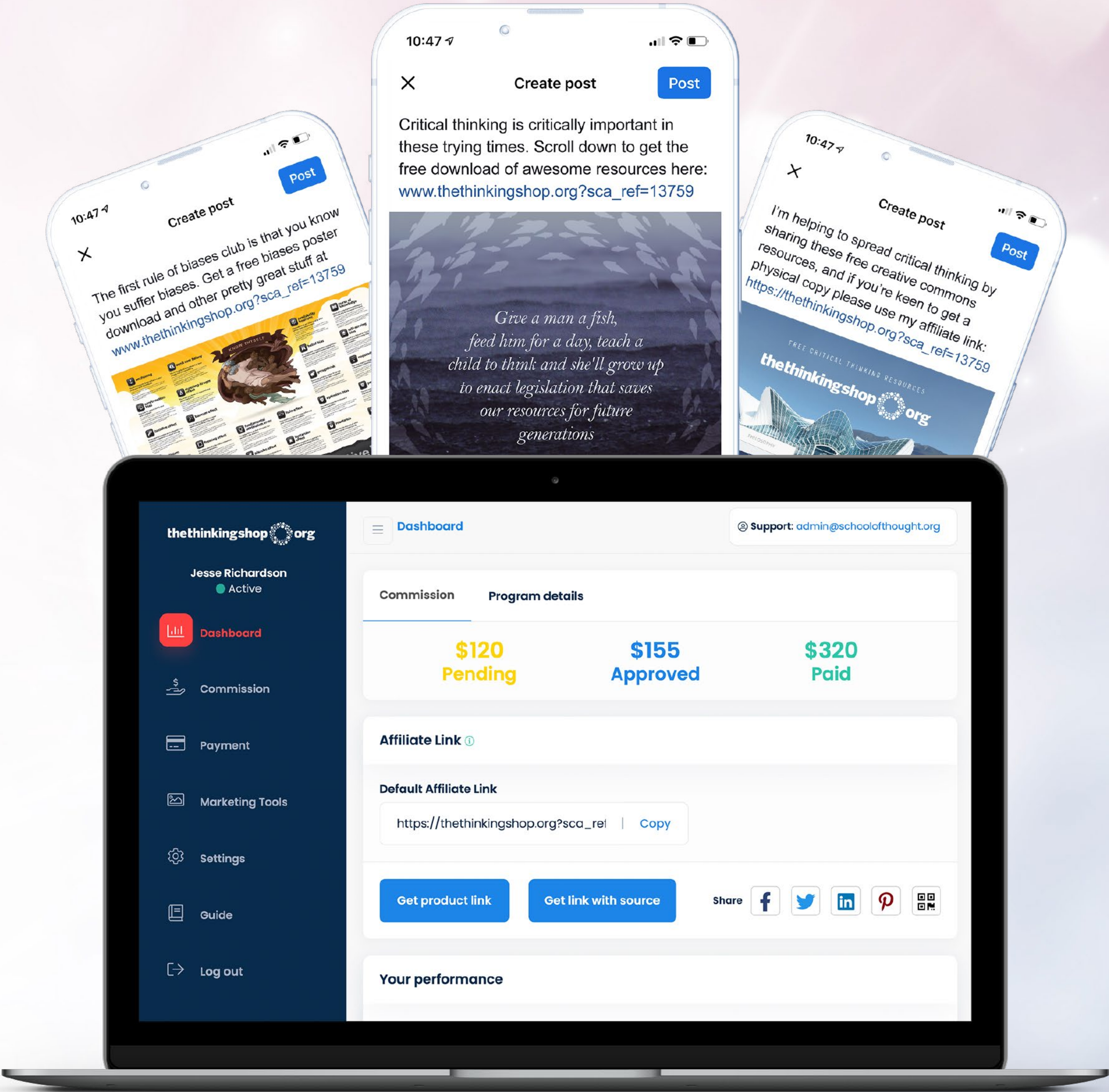
We’d really much rather give money to you than multinational advertising companies.

After you sign up you’ll be able to track your sales data via your login. Payments are made via PayPal at the end of each month.

To give some context and transparency, platforms like Facebook charge anywhere between \$15 - \$25 per sale which makes our margins pretty tight on an average order value of around \$40 once manufacturing and other overheads are accounted for. We’d rather pay you \$10 than Facebook \$20, then use the other \$10 to create more free resources.

So far, we've created four interactive websites that help to promote rationality and critical thinking, plus our main site and shop, and we're adding more soon.

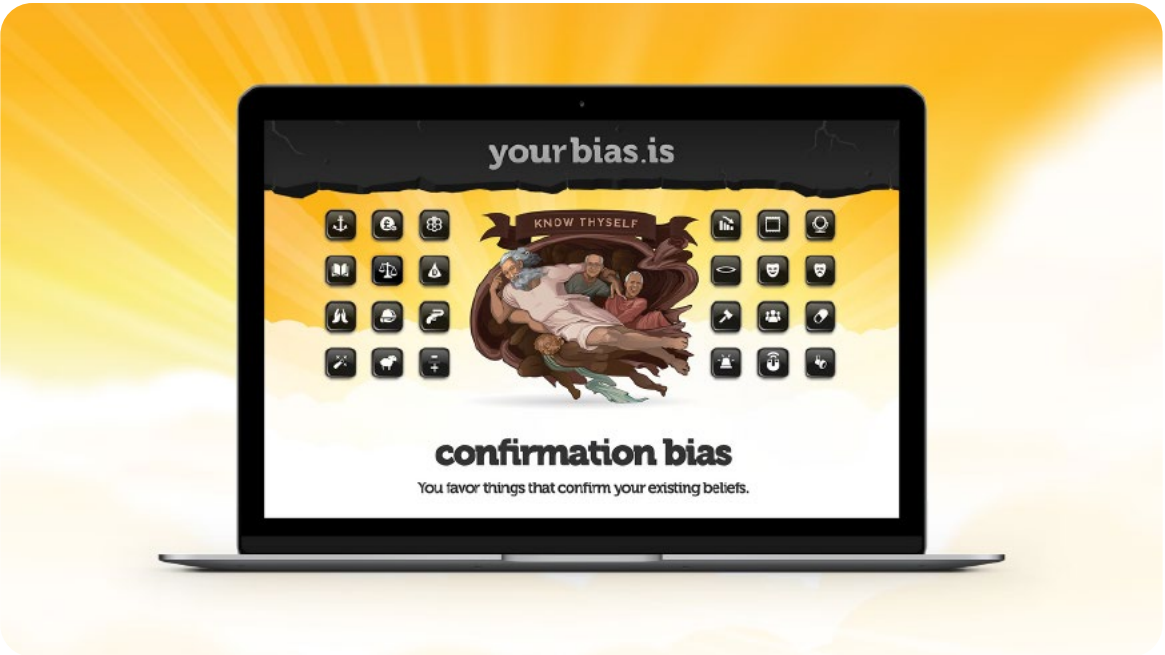
When you paste a website address into any social media post it will automatically generate a preview image which will appear underneath whatever you choose to say in your post (see page 9 for some inspiration).

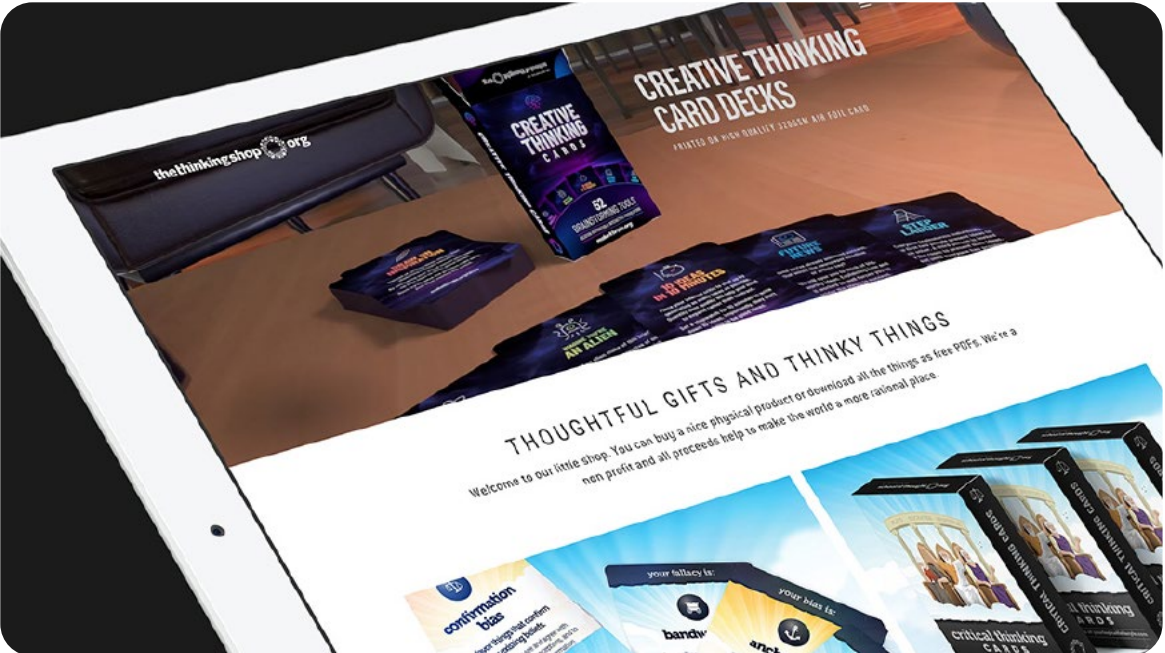

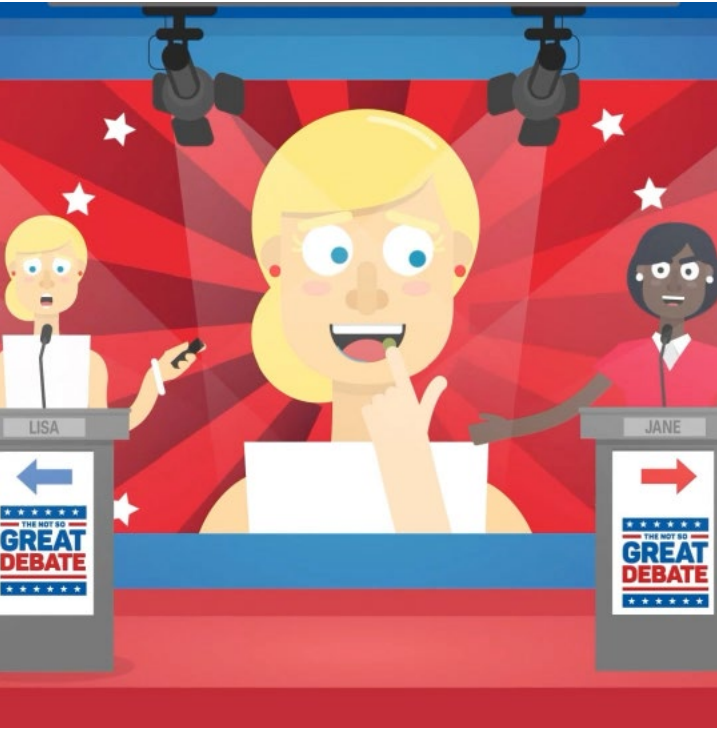
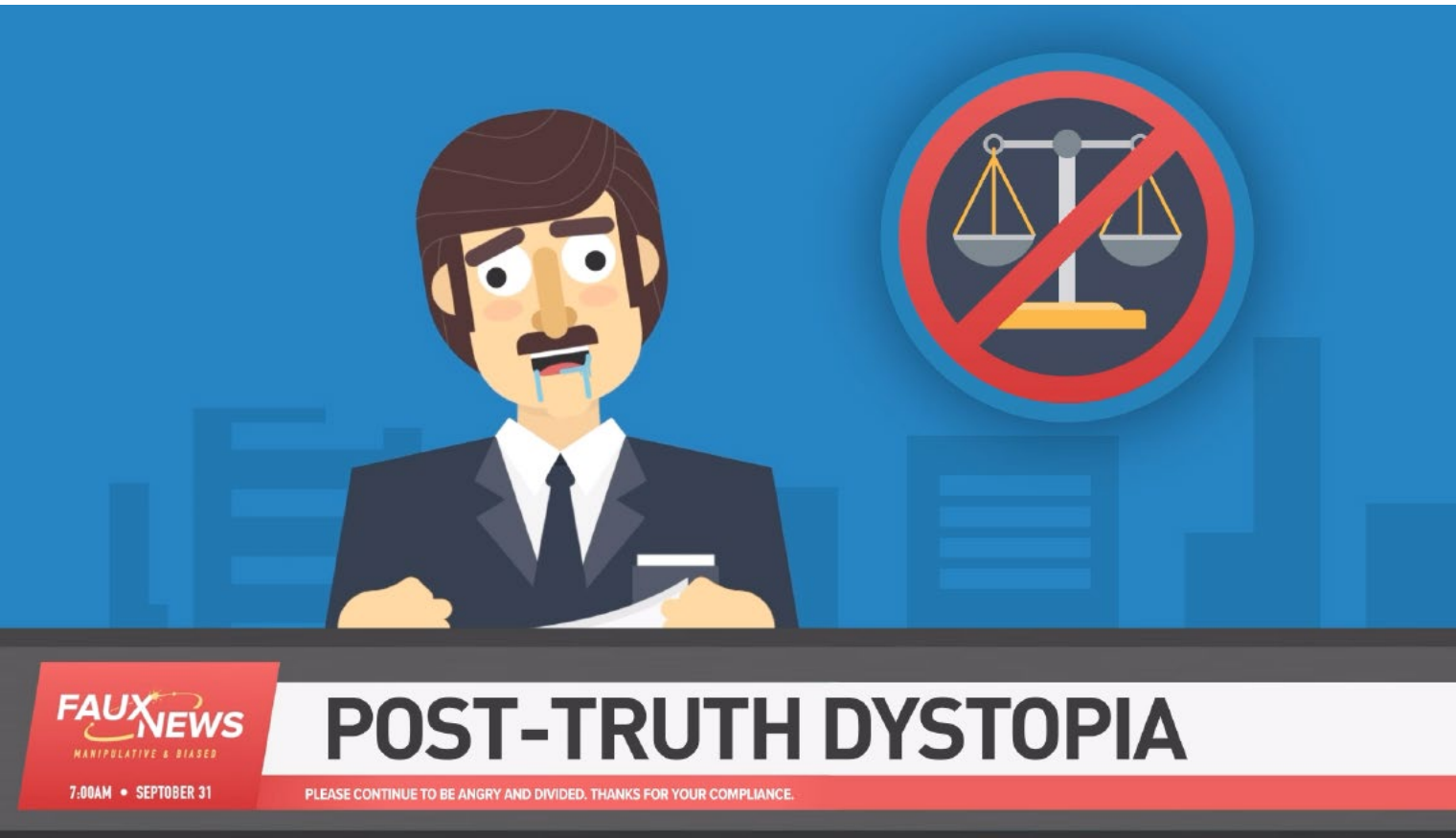

Videos

Videos tend to work better than any other kind of media to engage people, but the way that social media platforms like Facebook work now, is that you have to upload your video rather than share from something like YouTube or Vimeo (using third party video platforms creates a link people have to click rather than just playing the video within Facebook).

Well, here’s a bunch of post copy ideas which you can copy, paste, edit and adapt however you like.

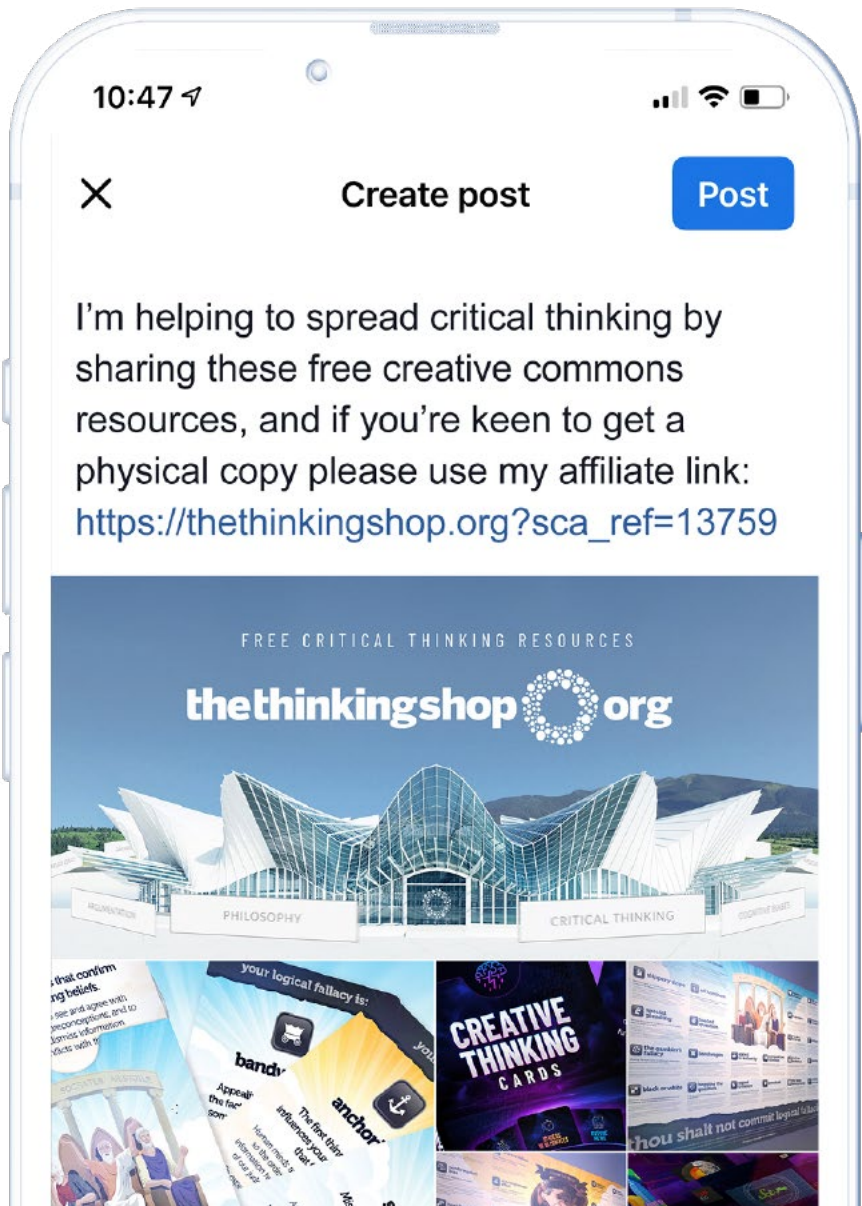

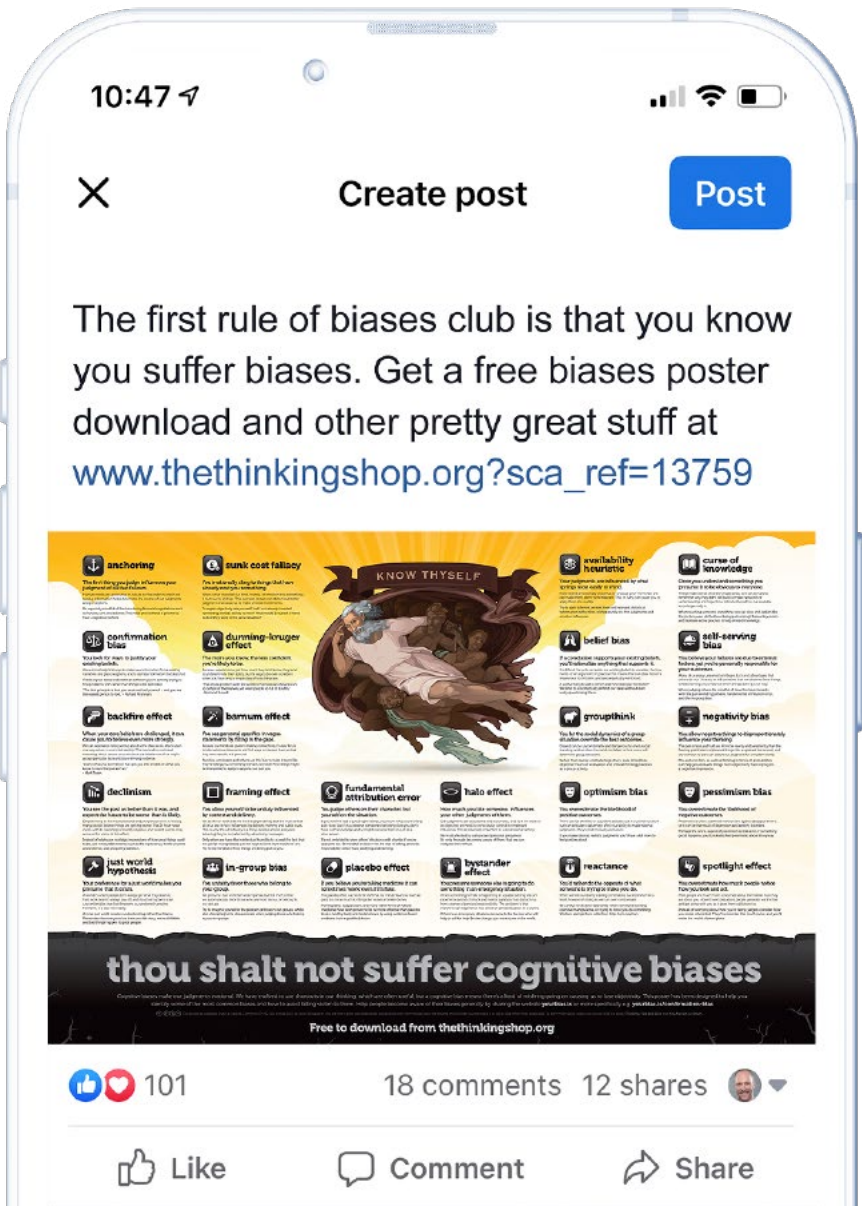

The first rule of biases club is that you know you suffer biases. Get a free biases poster download and other pretty great stuff at <yourbias.is link / thinking shop affiliate link>

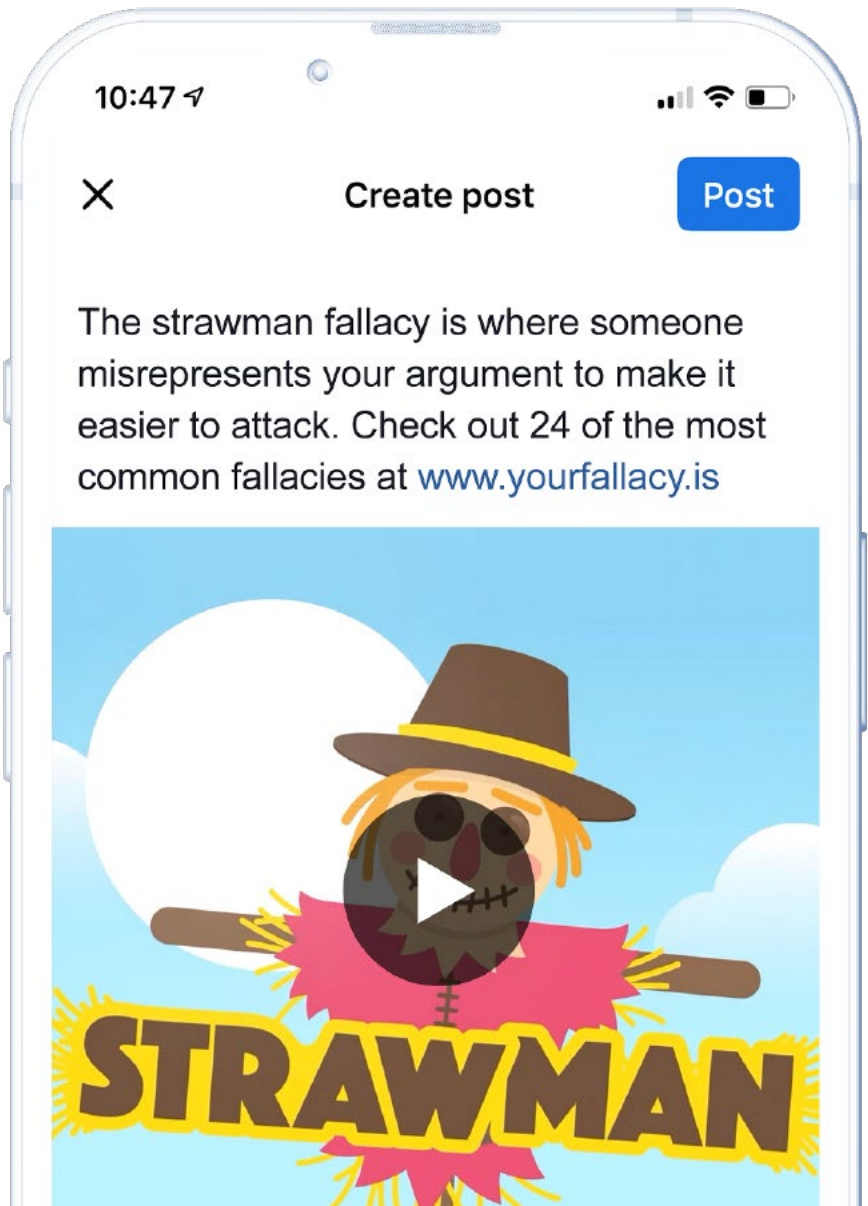
